DELIQUATREMEN

DTs can occur when you stop drinking alcohol after a period of heavy or prolonged alcohol use.



SYMPTOMS MAY INCLUDE:

- Delirium (severe confusion)
- Body tremors
- Changes in mental function
- Agitation, irritability
- Deep sleep that lasts
 Seizures can also for a day or longer
- Excitement or fear
- Hallucinations

- Burst of energy
- Quick mood changes
- Restlessness
- Sensory sensitivity
- Stupor, sleepiness, fatigue
- occur, with or without other symptoms

DTs are serious and may require medical intervention.

Call your healthcare provider or 911 if you suspect you may be experiencing them or have a past history of alcohol complications.
